

Call for Submission of Proposals to Host 2016 Symposium of 3-D Analysis of Human Movement

Technical Group of the International Society of Biomechanics

Symposia are held every other year. The Thirteenth International Symposium will be held in Lausanne, Switzerland, on July 2014. The host is 3-D Analysis of Human Movement President Kamiar Aminian and the location for the symposium will be the Ecole Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne. Proposals to host the Fourteenth International Symposium in 2016 are now being accepted. The symposium attracts approximately 100 individuals to present and discuss issues relating to the measurement of human movement in three dimensions. The meeting typically is held over a three day period in the summer. The program consists of invited speakers, podium sessions and poster sessions.

A one page proposal identifying the host of the meeting and describing the affiliated institution and the facilities available for the meeting is requested. Additional information about the organizing committee and potential topics for the meeting is welcome but not essential. Also, tourist information about the region is useful since the meeting may coincide with summer holidays. The selection will be based also on the record of research for human movement analysis from the hosting group, and on previous commitments with the 3DAHM Group'
