

Copyright Policy

Copyrighted Materials

User-Generated Content

2. If you submit content to our website, such as product reviews or comments, you grant us a non-exclusive, worldwide, perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free license to use, modify, distribute, and display that content in any form or media. You represent and warrant that you have the necessary rights to grant us this license.

DMCA Notices

3. If you believe that your copyrighted material has been infringed upon on our website, please send a DMCA notice to our designated agent at the following address:

Your DMCA notice should include the following information:

- A physical or electronic signature of the copyright owner or a person authorized to act on their behalf;
- Identification of the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed;
- Identification of the allegedly infringing material and its location on our website;

- Your contact information, including your address, telephone number, and email address;
- A statement that you have a good faith belief that the use of the material in the manner complained of is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law;
- A statement that the information in your notice is accurate, and under penalty of perjury, that you are the copyright owner or authorized to act on their behalf.

Counter-Notices

4. If you believe that your content was removed from our website in error or as a result of a mistake or misidentification, you may send a counter-notice to our designated agent. Your counter-notice should include the following information:
 - Your physical or electronic signature;
 - Identification of the material that has been removed or disabled and the location where the material appeared on our website;
 - A statement under penalty of perjury that you have a good faith belief that the material was removed or disabled as a result of mistake or misidentification;
 - Your name, address, telephone number, and email address; and
 - A statement that you consent to the jurisdiction of the federal district court for the judicial district in which your address is located or, if your address is outside of the USA, for any judicial district in which we may be found, and that you will accept service of process from the person who submitted the original DMCA notice or an agent of such person.

Repeat Infringers

5. We reserve the right to terminate the accounts of users who repeatedly infringe upon the copyrights of others.
