



Toy Gun... rubber band launcher!

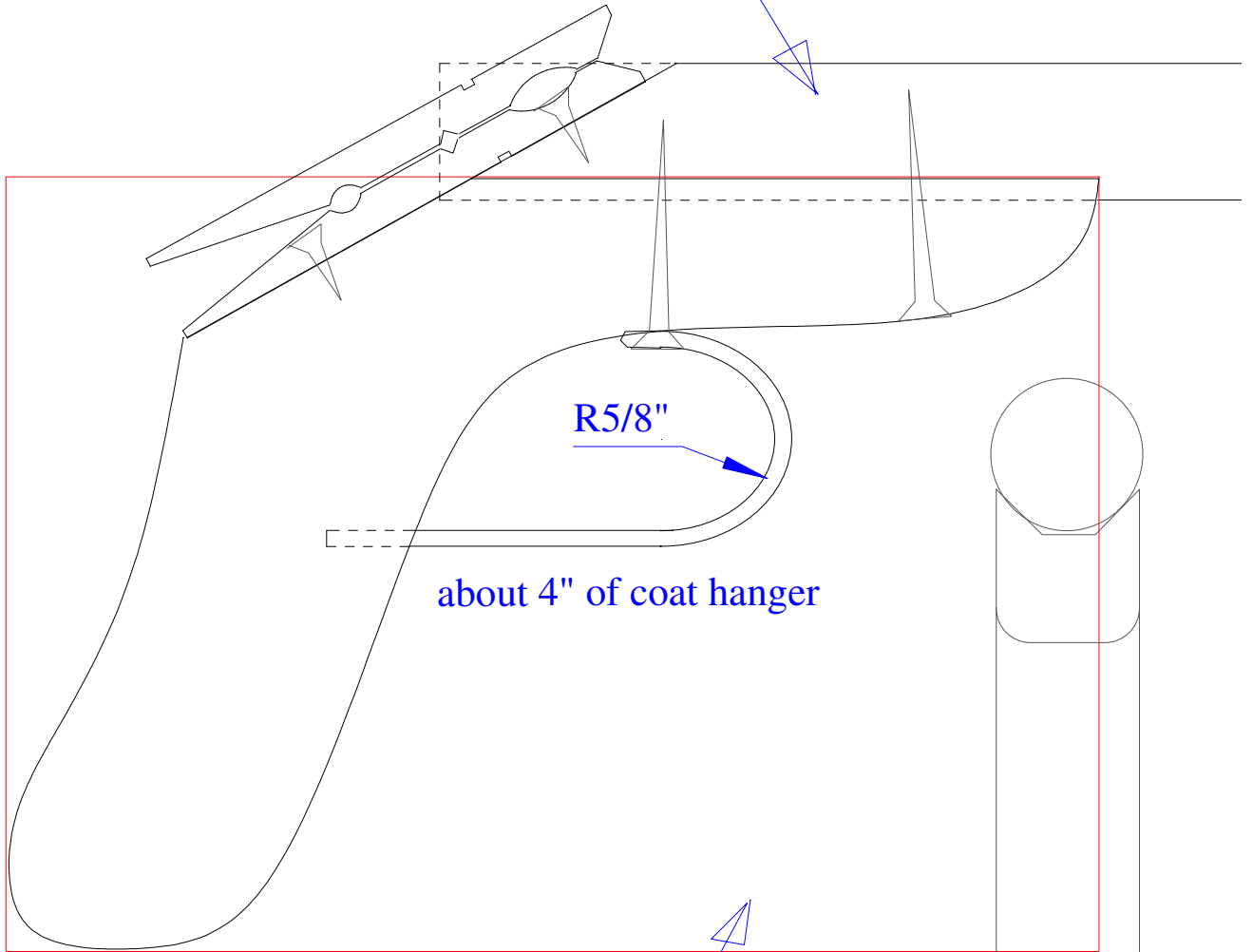


Fun to make and really fun to use...

Bois Artisanal



3/4" x 7 7/8" wood dowel



about 4" of coat hanger

R5/8"

3/4" x 6" x 4 1/4" pine board



- 1 - You can print page 2 and trace the full size pattern of the gun handle.
- 2 - round off the edges except the top part that holds the barrel.
- 3 - groove out the notch that rests the barrel by using a table saw.
(I made two passes wide down the center then one on each side at 45°) Be sure to adjust the depth by first tracing the cutout.
- 4 - trim the end of the barrel once it's attached to the handle.
- 5 - on small parts like these, you need to predrill all the holes before driving in the screws.
- 6 - disassemble the clothes pin to predrill and fasten the bottom half to the gun. Then reassemble it on the gun.
- 7 - set the rubber band in the clothes pin first then pull across the top of the barrel and hook to end.
- 8 - now you're ready to hunt down your first indian.
