We have had a very happy start to school. The gradual opening schedule can be trying on families' schedules; we appreciate your help in allowing the School to be sensitive to the needs of the youngest children as they transition to their new preschool environment.

The opening days of school are always filled with excitement and new experiences. During the first weeks of school, we focus on daily life in preschool and school routines. These include learning the layout of the equipment, personal hygiene, assembling for circle time, getting to and from the playground, safety guidelines, learning each other's names, and table manners.

This week the children will begin to explore a variety of art materials. They will be discovering the power of color blending and creating new colors not found in our



paint pots. Rather than insist on fastidiousness, children are encouraged to freely explore the art materials. In the course of this exuberant artistic endeavor, it is not uncommon for

children to accidentally smear small amounts of "washable" paint and markers on their shirts. Dress your child accordingly!

Summer is a hard habit to break! Those mornings of lolling in bed and pajama's are fading memories. If you find that you have arrived after 8:15am please note the following:

- Children who arrive after the roll has been taken at 8:15am are recorded as absent
- If you arrive after 8:15am, drop your child at the classroom door
- Go to the Office to report your child's arrival
- When you go to the Office, Joanne Miller will record your child's arrival
- If you know in advance that you will be arriving late or if your child will be absent, a call to the classroom (610) 642-2334, ext 121, or an e-mail to the classroom teacher would be helpful.

This is a night for parents and teachers to meet together in the classroom to discuss the program - line up your babysitters soon.


