Resurrection Service

Both of us had the opportunity to participate in serving during this worship service/outreach to our city on Easter Sunday. The service was held at our local performing arts center, which holds over 1,000 people and it was nearly filled. Julie was blessed to join with the choir and help with the music portion of the service, while Dejan ushered and handled some set-up and sound advice. Then afterwards, we both met with those who came forward at the invitation to accept the Lord for the first time. Praise the Lord for the new lives of several young adults and three precious children! Jesus is alive and saving people here!

Spring Fair Outreach



The following weekend, we celebrated Dejan's 30th birthday by going out and sharing the gospel. Exhibitors from all over the area and nearby states were having an expo at our local arena, and our church bookstore was able to get a space, from which we could freely witness the truth to passers-by. Mostly we conducted surveys with individuals, couples or small groups, which led eventually to questions of morality and faith. It was such a blessing to dialog with people of all backgrounds and to help them realize that God punishes sin and that we can't avoid hell by living a good life, only by trusting Jesus' payment of our punishment at the cross. Seeing the "light" go on was a precious blessing. We also gave away \$1

million dollar bills with the gospel message on the back, and many people were coming to ask for more to pass out to their friends!

Children's Ministry

Our time serving the four- and five-year old class on Sunday mornings has ended, as we are starting our own private children's ministry (having a baby!), but what a blessing to see these kids latch onto some of the simple truths of God's Word! We finished the book of Acts with them, and they not only know who Paul is, they know that everywhere he went he was telling people about Jesus. They also learned about what sin is and how we get to heaven and why we need Jesus. Also, we were recently blessed with an apartment to live in while we are in the States, as the LORD fully (and swiftly!) opened that door for us. Now we have a place for our new family to dwell in and are abounding in thanksgiving to God for touching the heart of His people to provide it for us.

One of the things we've seen being back in the States is how the Lord has truly knit *His Body* together and is giving us a more secure place in it through the fellowship of believers. This is both in our local church but also in those of you who are continually lifting us up in prayer and helping us financially and logistically through this season when neither of us are able to work a "normal" job.
