(Spanish-American War, WWI, WWII, Korean War and Vietnam War)

1. Explain how the wars began (causes)? How did the U.S. get involved?
2. Explain how America mobilized for the war? What was happening during the war in America? How did we fight the war?
3. What were the results of each conflict? Did the world or America change because of the war?

Questions on Civil Rights Movements in U.S. history

(Women, African-Americans and other minority groups)

1. Identify and explain the contribution of individual people on the movement?
2. Identify and explain the contribution of groups or organizations on the movement?
3. Identify and explain any important involvement by the Federal government on the movements? (ie. Federal laws, Presidential Executive Orders or Supreme Court cases)
4. Explain whether the movements were successful or not? If the movement was successful, how was the movement's success achieved? If the movement was unsuccessful, explain why the movement was unable to achieve its goals?

Questions on Domestic Programs in U.S. history

(Square Deal, Wilson's New Freedom, New Deal, Fair Deal, Great Society)

1. Explain why the programs were started or needed?
2. Explain the goals that each program was to achieve?
3. Explain whether the goals were achieved and how they were achieved?
4. Explain the lasting impact on America by these programs?
