Baruch Scouts Testimony

GEORGETOWN, S. C., Feb. 27
(AP)—Bernard M. Baruch denied today that he had talked with Mr. Ziapkov during the Paris peace conference on Bulgaria in 1946, as alleged in the pastor's confession.

"I was not in Paris in 1946, my first trip outside this country since the war's end being last year," he said in a statement. "Nor do I have any recollection of having seen him (Ziapkov) anywhere else or at any time."
