What is assessment ?

- A carefully considered opinion or judgement (*Oxford dictionary*)
- Evaluation
- Situation analysis

Requires

- To be systematic/ Scientific



Objective of Assessment

- To analyse the current situations of health care system in eastern region
- To analyse general situation of community
- To establish baseline information as a basis for developing plans, monitoring, evaluation
- To identify suitable interventions/ methods for capacity strengthening of partners and community.



Specific Objectives of Assessment

- To identify the current socio-economic, demographic situation that affects the health of community people.
- To identify the gaps in provision of quality care at different level of health care particularly to TB/HIV/STI/AIDS, ED, ID and RH



Specific Objectives of Assessment

- To identify community practices for the utilization of health care services in particular in-
 - Accessibility to services
 - Barriers to utilize existing services
 - Barriers to change behaviours
- To identify specific health concerns /needs of community people.



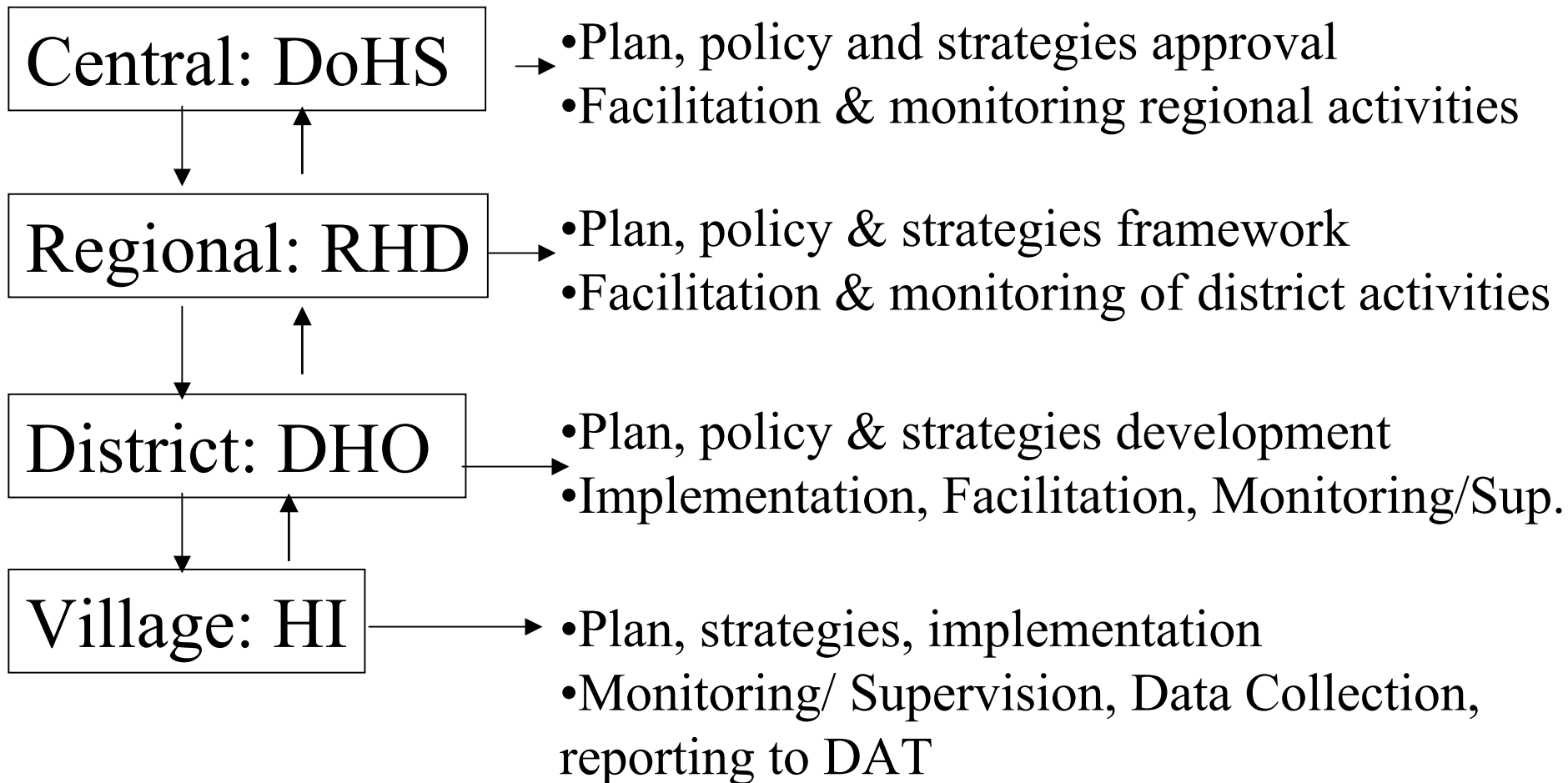
Approach of Assessment

- Participatory
- Involvement of partners in PIE cycle
- Purposive sampling to disadvantaged population.

 - Supervision/ monitoring
- **Regional Level**
 - Situation Analysis Workshop
 - Team Formation (Central, Regional, District, HI)
 - Tools / Guidelines development
 - Consultants involvement

- **District Level**
 - **District Assessment Workshop**
 - **Orientation**
 - **Sample VDCs selection**
 - **Tools test**
 - **Planning for data collection process**

- VDC level or Health Institution level
 - Orientation
 - Selection of Wards/ clusters
 - Plan of Action

- **Planning with Partners**



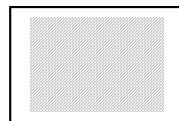
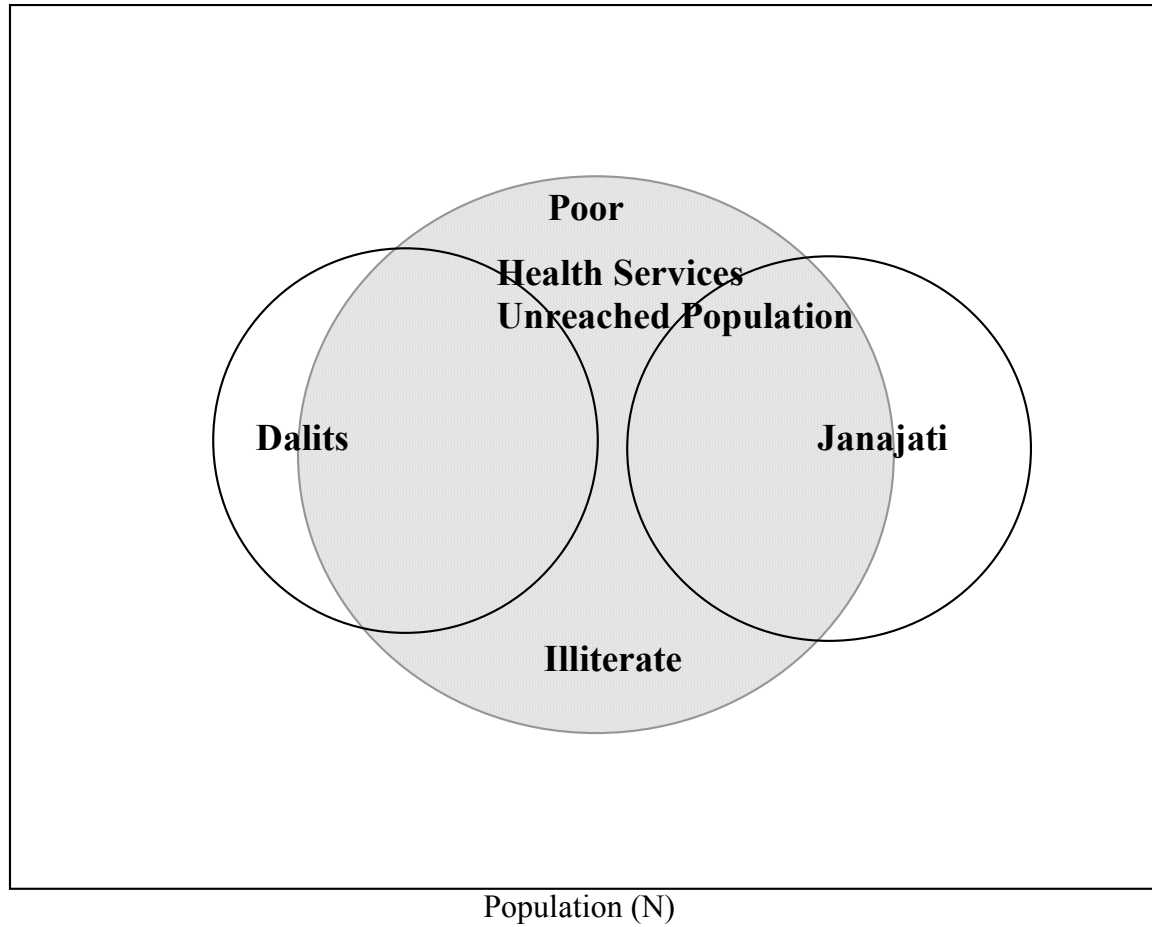
District Assessment Workshop

- Presentation on Health services coverage/ utilization status of all VDCs in the district by District Health Office (DHO/PHO)
- Presentation on Literacy Status of all VDCs in district by District Education Office (EDO)
- Presentation on the location (VDCs) of poor and Dalit/ Janajati in the district by DDC (LDO or Planning Officer of DDC)
- Identification and Finalization of disadvantaged VDCs, Health Institutions as Sample sites by District Mapping/ PRA

HI/VDC/Community Orientation

- Presentation on Health service coverage/ utilization status of clusters/ wards in the VDC by Health Institution's Incharge
- Presentation on Literacy Status in cluster/ wards in the VDC by Headmaster of High/ School.
- Presentation on the location of poor and Dalit/ Janajati clusters in the VDC by VDC Chairman/ Executive
