



Oakville 2nd Glen Abbey Spring Canoe Trip Algonquin Park Camp Information & Registration

Date: On May 16, 17 & 18th weekend the Section Leadership team have organized a fantastic camp experience. The trip will start at access point 4, Rain Lake. The canoe trip will take us down Rain Lake into Sawyer Lake where we will set camp for the first night. The next day we will portage and paddle our way to Jubilee Lake and set camp. Sunday we will canoe back to Rain Lake and head for home around 3:00pm. Depending on traffic and weather in the Park we should be home by 8:00pm.
