Rebecca's Story

At the age of 14 Rebecca Price Janney won two writing contents and became her high school's correspondent for the Allentown, Pennsylvania Morning Call teen supplement. Her first big story came from an interview with Apollo 17's Harrison Schmitt, the last man to walk on the moon

The following year she went boldy where no woman had gone before—into the Philadelphia Phillies dugout to write stories for The Phillipsburg Free Press. During a seven-year stint, she traveled widely and interviewed players such as Mike Schmidt, Pete Rose, Johnny Bench, Reggie Jackson, George Brett, and Tug McGraw. In 1976 Rebecca was a runner-up in the Seventeen Magazine-Columbia Scholastic Press Association teenager-of-the-year contest. Her first magazine story appeared in Seventeen.

She has written for dozens of magazines and newspapers including, Guideposts, Decision, Moody Monthly, The War Cry, and Focus on the Family.

In 1993 her eight-book Heather Reed Mystery Series debuted. Rebecca also has published the three-book Impossible Dreamers Series, Great Women in American History, Great Stories in American History, Great Letters in American History, and Harriet Tubman

She graduated from Lafayette College with an A.B. in history, received a Master of Divinity from Princeton Theological Seminary, and earned a doctorate from Biblical Theological Seminary. Her dissertation was on the role of women in the Protestant church and society throughout American history and its impact on the faithfulness of contemporary evangelical women.
