'Born in 1877, Dr Edmond Locard was a French criminalist renowned for being a pioneer in forensic science and criminology, often informally referred to as the "Sherlock Holmes of France".' (the forensics library) (If you don't know who Sherlock Holmes is then you can go to the Sherlock holmes site.) He was known as "Sherlock Holmes of France because of how good he was at solving how people died.
"During the First World War, Locard worked with the French Secret Service as a medical examiner, attempting to identify cause and location of death by examining the stains and damage of soldiers' and prisoners' uniforms." He was one of the first forensic scientists in history. As well as helping soldiers and solving cases he also made the famous quote being: "Every contact leaves a trace." and another quote being my favorite was "Genius is the talent of a person who is dead." -Edmond Locard
