To give away 284 pairs of spectacles to selected poor students in 21 primary schools: (7 Sekolah Rendah Kebangsaan, 8 Sekolah Rendah Jenis Kebangsaan Cina, and 6 Sekolah Rendah Jenis Kebangsaan Tamil, in Negeri Sembilan). These students have had their eyes screened at Focus Point prior to this event. We have actually targeted to give away 300 pairs of spectacles but were unable to get more schools to come.

This project was jointly held by the Lions Club of Seremban Central and Focus Point Vision Care Group with the kind permission of Mesyuarat Jawatankuasa Induk Perayaan Sambutan Hari Keputeraan Ke-84 DYMM Yang DiPertuan Besar Negeri Sembilan.

Chan Kim Fei comes from a poor family . He is the youngest child of Mr Chan Ah Choong. Kim Fei has 2 normal healthy brothers. He has scoliosis since he was born. When he was about 1 years-old , he suffered an injury. Since then he has become a paraplegic and cannot get around on his own. His grandparents take care of him, but they are already in their seventies. Apparently they need to carry Kim Fei whenever they go for his medical check ups. This is a great



strain on the elderly couple. With the wheelchair we hope this will at least ease their burden . Also this will make Kim Fei more mobile as he can wheel out of house to enjoy the outdoors instead of just staying indoor.
