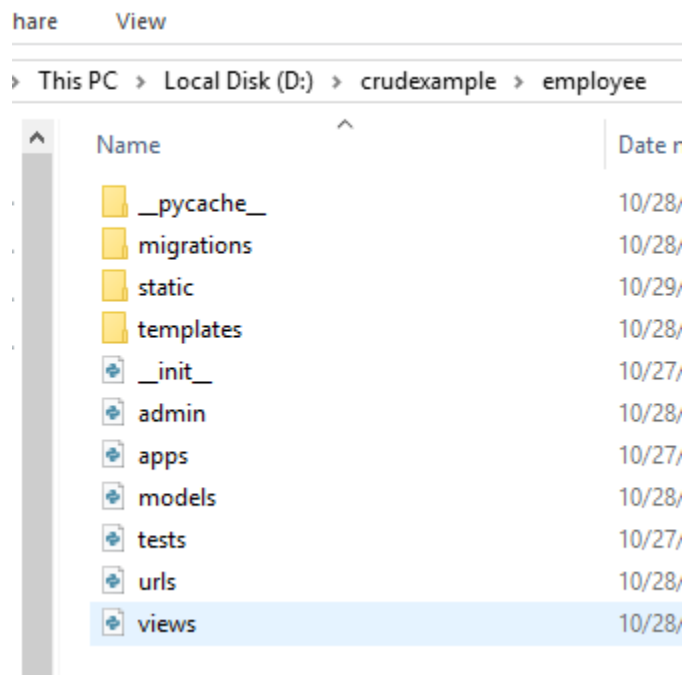


## Django JavaScript example :-

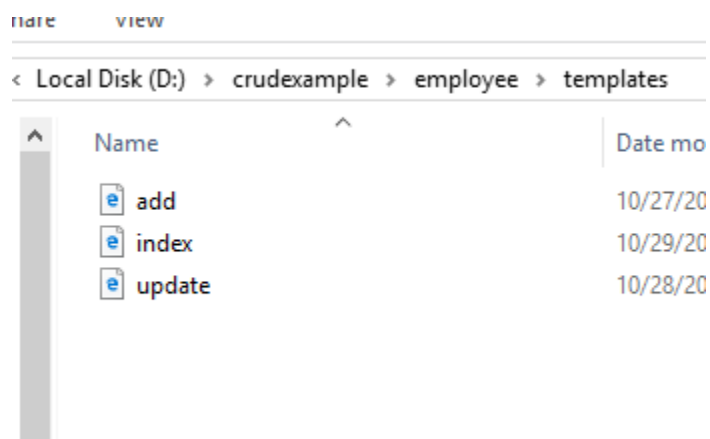
First of all create **static** folder inside your app folder (employee) as shown below:-



Inside static folder create javascript file **ok.js** :-

```
function myFunction() {  
    alert("Hello from a static file!");  
}
```

And now open your **index.html** file under templates folder :-



# Modify the html file (index.html)

Now you have a css file, with some css properties that will style an HTML page. The next step will be to include this file in a HTML template:

Open the HTML file and add the following:

```
{% load static %}
```

And:

```
<script src="{% static 'ok.js' %}"></script>
```

And write code of `index.html` file as shown below:-

```
<html>
<head>
{% load static %}
<script src="{% static 'ok.js' %}"></script>

</head>
<body>
<button onclick="myFunction()">Click me!</button>
</body>
</html>
```

Restart the server for the changes to take effect:

```
py manage.py runserver
```

```
C:\Users\software>d:
D:\>cd crudexample
D:\crudexample>py manage.py runserver
```

In output :-
