

Installing **n8n** depends on how you want to use it: locally

Recommended for Local Use: Install via npm (Node.js)

Prerequisites:

- **Node.js** (v18+ recommended)
- **npm** (comes with Node.js)

Steps:

```
npm install -g n8n
```

open your command prompt and type this command as shown below:-

```
C:\Users\User>npm install -g n8n  
npm WARN EBADENGINE overriding peer dependency
```

Then Run:-

```
n8n
```

as shown below type in command prompts:-

```
C:\Users\User>n8n
```

→ This starts n8n at <http://localhost:5678>

As shown below example:-

```
C:\Users\User>n8n
Initializing n8n process
n8n ready on ::, port 5678
