PEMBAHASAN BAHASA INGGRIS

2007/2008

1. **Residents** memiliki arti orang yang tinggal atau dalam konteks tersebut adalah orang yang memiliki rumah di *housing complex*, jadi jawaban yang tepat adalah *people* (penduduk).
Jawaban: C
2. Pada tahun 2008 Eleanor berumur 15 tahun maka pada tahun 2016 yang berarti 8 tahun kemudian, umurnya adalah 23 tahun.
Jawaban: D
3. Eleanor lahir 15 tahun yang lalu. Itu berarti pada tahun 1993.
Jawaban: C
4. Phrase **keep off** memiliki arti jauhi atau hindari jadi kata yang tepat untuk mengisi titik-titik tersebut adalah **not walk on**.
Jawaban: D
5. Teks tersebut adalah sebuah pengumuman dengan indikasi mengundang untuk mengumpulkan tulisan (*invites submission*), disebutkan pula tentang kategori (*categories*), dan waktu pengumpulan (*postmark submission*) jadi tujuan teks tersebut adalah **to announce** atau mengumumkan lomba menulis.
Jawaban : B
6. Dari keempat jawaban yang tidak disebutkan hanya **unpublished** sedang **typewritten** disebutkan di paragraf kedua, **original** dianalogikan dari kata kunci **manuscript** yang berarti naskah asli, sedang **easy to read** tersirat dari persyaratan untuk mencantumkan judul dan informasi lain di lembar terpisah dengan tujuan mempermudah proses pembacaan (*easy to read*).
Jawaban : B
7. Larangan itu berbunyi bahwa jangan mengarahkan kamera ke sinar matahari secara langsung atau cahaya lain yang kuat karena akan merusak mata sehingga jawaban yang benar adalah **our eyes might be in danger if the camera is aimed into the sun or intense light**.

13. **Interested** berarti tertarik dan memiliki kesamaan arti dengan **really likes**.
Jawaban: B
14. Bacaan seperti ini berusaha memberi kejutan pada pembaca. Hal yang paling menonjol dari bacaan tersebut adalah bagian terakhir = *Amelia's mother was **puzzled** to see her daughter talking alone* (Ibu Amelia heran melihat anaknya berbicara sendiri). Padahal jelas diceritakan dalam teks bahwa Amelia berbicara dengan seorang seorang gadis. Maka kalimat terakhir ini merupakan kunci yang menunjukkan bahwa gadis yang diajak bicara oleh Amelia adalah gadis yang misterius.
Jawaban: A
15. Paragraf pertama mendeskripsikan tempat di mana Amelia sekarang sedang berada. Jadi jawaban yang tepat untuk menjelaskan apa yang dijelaskan



pada paragraf pertama adalah **the setting place of the story**.

Jawaban: D

16. Pada kalimat pertama di paragraf kedua disebutkan **If I could..** yang merupakan ungkapan keinginan sehingga jawabannya adalah **to fly up to the top of the mountain**.

Jawaban: B

17. *bad smell* : bau tidak enak
nice taste : rasa enak
bitter taste : rasa pahit
stale flavour : rasa tahan lama
Delicious memiliki arti lezat sehingga memiliki arti yang sama dengan **nice taste**.

22. Passport, visa dan surat ijin keluar adalah merupakan berkas-berkas atau **documents**.

Jawaban: D

23. They travelled in a comfortable coach with a toilet, music, and video. The guide stopped at **many famous places**. He explained **the cultural importance of the places**. They **stayed in big hotels for the night and ate in the restaurant**.

Jelas bahwa paragraf tersebut berisi tentang hal-hal yang menyenangkan dari perjalanan mereka bahwa mereka mengunjungi tempat-tempat yang menarik (*interesting*) karena terkenal dan penting.

Jawaban: C

24. **"Enjoyed"** berarti menikmati sehingga sinonimnya yang paling tepat adalah **"got pleasure from"**.

Jawaban: B

25. Teks tersebut berisi tentang **hair tonik** yang merupakan bahan untuk merawat rambut. Sehingga jawaban yang benar adalah mendeskripsikan tentang perawatan rambut atau **hair treatment**.

Jawaban: D

26. Pada kalimat kedua menyebutkan bahwa tonik diberikan pada rambut yang jarang (*thin*) sehingga fungsi dari tonik itu adalah untuk membuat rambut menjadi tebal (*to help stimulate hair growth*).

Jawaban: C

27. Dari jawaban yang tersedia semuanya dapat ditemukan di dalam teks sehingga jawaban yang benar adalah **all beats**.

Jawaban: D

28. Jawaban dapat ditemukan di paragraf pertama kalimat kedua dengan kata kunci **pleased** yang dapat berarti senang karena **flock** (kumpulan domba) miliknya bertambah jumlah.

Jawaban: A

29. Nilai moral yang terkandung di dalamnya dapat dilihat dari kalimat **"if you prefer us new animals to your sheep, how will you treat us if you find some more animals in your flock"** (par. 4) = jika kamu lebih menyukai kami binatang baru dari pada domba-dombamu, bagaimana kamu akan memperlakukan kami jika kamu menemukan lebih banyak binatang dalam gembalamu.

Jadi pada intinya, bacaan ini berpesan untuk tidak melupakan yang lama bila telah menemukan yang baru.

Jawaban: D

30. Dari kata **request** yang diikuti dengan akan diadakannya suatu perayaan maka teks tersebut berniat untuk meminta kehadirannya atau dalam kata lain mengundang.

Jawaban: A

31. Pernyataan yang benar adalah bahwa tamu harap memberi tahu sebelum kedatangan pada Zu Bakir dengan kata kunci R.S.V.P kependekan dari **"response s'il vous plait"** yang kurang lebih berarti mohon memberi tahu atau memberi tahu (*inform*).

Jawaban: A

35. Dari teks diketahui bahwa Tikka Kebab adalah nama makanan dan di bawahnya dijelaskan tentang komposisi dan langkah-langkah sehingga dapat disimpulkan bahwa teks ini memberitahu tentang cara membuat Tikka Kebab (*tell how to make Kebab*).

Jawaban: A

36. Dari paragraf pertama jelas disebutkan bahwa terdapat 5 (five) bahan untuk membuat Kebab.

Jawaban: C

37. **Them** pada langkah kedua mengarah pada kata-kata yang disebutkan sebelumnya pada kalimat yang sama yaitu **lamb, green pepper, dan onion**.

Jawaban: D

38. Tujuan Mirda menulis surat terdapat pada paragraf kedua kalimat keempat yang menyebutkan bahwa dia ingin menjadi *pen pal* (sahabat pena).

Jawaban: B

39. Dari paragraf pertama kalimat ketiga menyebutkan bahwa meraka bertemu di kebun binatang (*zoo*) Ragunan.

Jawaban: C

40. Pernyataan Emily pada kalimat kedua di paragraf kedua menyebutkan bahwa dia sekarang berada di tingkat 11 yang memiliki tingkatan yang sama dengan SMA atau *Senior High School*.

Jawaban: B

41. *...natural oil which surrounds the ears surface = ... natural oil yang berada di sekitar telinga.*

Jawaban: C

42. Paragraf kedua, ide pokok terletak di akhir paragraf. Bahwa kelinci dapat mendeteksi musuh dan bagaimana dia dapat melakukan hal tersebut telah dijelaskan di paragraf kedua yaitu karena kupingnya.

Jawaban: B

43. Tujuan dari bacaan tersebut adalah untuk mengetahui pentingnya kuping kelinci yang besar.

Terlihat dari judul bacaan itu yaitu untuk mendiskripsikan pentingnya telinga kelinci bagi dia.

Jawaban: C
