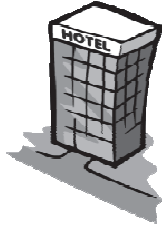

*Various* yang bermakna bermacam-macam maksudnya ada banyak dan tidak sama. Jadi, jawaban yang tepat adalah *different*.

**Jawaban: A**

16. Apa fungsi dari mangkuk yang kecil?

Perhatikan *Steps 5*! Di sana tertulis *Take three spoonfuls of mixed fruit and put them in a small bowl* = Ambil tiga sendok penuh campuran buah dan taruh di mangkuk kecil.

**Jawaban: B**

17. Steps 2: Potong stroberi dan anggur menjadi dua bagian.

Steps 3: Iris tebal-tebal pisang

Steps 4: Masukkan semua buah tersebut kemudian campur.

Jadi, setelah semua buah dipotong-potong lalu dimasukkan menjadi satu di dalam mangkuk besar.

**Jawaban: B**

18. Chunks = tebal-tebal

A. small pieces = irisan kecil-kecil

B. large amount = jumlah yang banyak

C. thick pieces = irisan-irisan tebal

D. thin pieces = irisan-irisan tipis

Jadi, kata yang bergaris bawah berarti *thick pieces*.

**Jawaban: C**

19. Apa yang merpati lakukan saat melihat seekor semut akan tercebur?

Lihat paragraf ketiga, *She saw the ant struggling, and quickly nipped off a leaf and let it fall into the water. The ant climbed upon it ...* = Merpati melihat si semut menyelamatkan diri, dan dengan cepat ia menjatuhkan selembar daun ke air. Si semut naik di atasnya...

**Jawaban: B**

20. Paragraf 2: *"I shall drown!" he cried. "Help! Help! Help!" but his voice was so tiny that it could not be heard*. Yang tidak dapat didengar adalah teriakan-nya (*ant's cry*).

**Jawaban: A**

21. Dalam cerita tersebut merpati menolong semut tanpa pamrih pada saat akan terjatuh ke sungai. Kemudian semut juga menolong merpati pada saat akan diburu tanpa pamrih dan diminta. Sehingga apa yang dapat dipelajari dari cerita tersebut ada-



lah hakikat sebuah pertemanan. Teman itu adalah seseorang yang selalu ada saat dibutuhkan.

**Jawaban: A**

22. Dari cerita tersebut disebutkan bahwa merpati membantu si semut saat akan tercebur ke sungai. Kemudian si semut menolong merpati saat hendak diburu. Jadi, cerita tersebut menceritakan bahwa mereka berdua saling membantu.

**Jawaban: C**

23. Perhatikan pada bagian *Direction*! Di sana terdapat kalimat *Do not use it for more than two weeks*. Sehingga tidak disarankan bagi konsumen menggunakan produk ini selama lebih dari dua minggu.

**Jawaban: D**

24. Irritation = sakit di bagian tubuh  
A. illness = penyakit  
B. pain = sakit di bagian tubuh  
C. injury = kerusakan  
D. hurt = sakit/menyakiti

Jadi, *irritation* bermakna serupa dengan *pain*.

**Jawaban: B**

25. Perhatikan kalimat terakhir dari paragraf 3! Disebutkan bahwa *The best time to visit the park is in the early morning or late afternoon, when it is cooler*.

Jadi, waktu yang tepat mengunjungi taman adalah *in the early morning atau late afternoon*.

**Jawaban: A**

26. Located = terletak/berada  
A. included = termasuk  
B. situated = bertempat  
C. kept = dijaga  
D. rebuilt = dibangun kembali

Maka, *located* juga dapat diartikan *situated* = terletak/bertempat.

**Jawaban: B**

27. Topik utama cerita berada di awal kalimat paragraf pertama, yaitu *it was my grandpa's birthday party last Sunday*.

**Jawaban: C**

28. Ide pokok dari paragraf 1 adalah: Lihat kalimat 1 hingga 3. Disebutkan bahwa penulis pergi ke mal membeli kemeja, kemudian dibungkus kertas biru untuk kakek. Maksudnya sebagai hadiah/kado = *present*.

**Jawaban: A**

29. A. **Salah**, karena pada kalimat ketiga paragraf 3 disebutkan *We sat together*

*in the living room*. Maksudnya pestaanya diadakan di dalam rumah, bukan di luar rumah.

B. **Benar** – Paragraf 2, kalimat pertama.

C. **Benar** – Paragraf 3, kalimat ketujuh.

D. **Benar** – Paragraf 3, kalimat kedelapan.

**Jawaban: A**

30. Simpanse suka tinggal di ...

Lihat kalimat kedua dari bacaan tersebut! *They like to stay on the ground, ..*

**Jawaban: C**

31. *Chimps like to search for termites, ants and never refuse of sweet fruits and nuts* = simpanse suka mencari semut, dan tidak pernah menolak aneka buah-buahan yang manis dan kacang-kacangan sebagai makanan. Jadi, yang bukan makanan simpanse adalah *small mammals*.

**Jawaban: A**

32. Teks tersebut menceritakan tempat seperti apa yang simpanse suka (kalimat 2). Kemudian apa yang dia suka lakukan (kalimat 3), apa makanannya (kalimat 4), dan bagaimana caranya berkomunikasi (kalimat 5). Jadi, dapat disimpulkan bahwa teks tersebut menceritakan kehidupan simpanse.

**Jawaban: D**

33. *Relatives* = cenderung serupa/sama.

**Jawaban: A**

34. Perhatikan kalimat kedua pada brosur, *soothing, sleek, and streamlined with the latest technology, our newly refurbished interiors raise the city's standard for sophisticated*. Jadi, yang diberi "sentuhan baru" adalah interior hotel.

**Jawaban: A**

35. Lihat kalimat 3! *Enhance your enjoyment in two inspired restaurants and the new Alfresco*.

**Jawaban: C**

36. *Soothing* berasal dari kata *soothe* yang berarti menenangkan dan nyaman.

*Sleek* bermakna lembut dan berkilau.

Maka, *soothing* = *quiet and calm*.

**Jawaban: C**

37. Kalimat ketiga, paragraf 2, *It must be exciting to be in Texas again*.

**Jawaban: B**

38. Kalimat keempat, paragraf 2, *Beside, I want to meet Eva, Helen, your father and mother*. Dari kalimat ini

dapat diketahui bahwa Johnson memiliki dua saudari, Eva, and Helen.

**Jawaban: A**

39. Surat tersebut ditujukan pada Johnson oleh Nowo. Sehingga *you* di sini ditujukan juga pada *Johnson*.

**Jawaban: C**

40. Confirm = memastikan  
A. To make sure = meyakinkan  
B. To show uncertainty = menunjukkan ketidakpastian  
C. To get information = untuk mendapatkan informasi  
D. To deliver the news = untuk mengirimkan berita

Jadi, *confirm* = *to make sure*

**Jawaban: A**

41. Perhatikan kalimat 3! *Then, put them in the washing machine, turn the machine on, set it to the wash selection and pour the detergent powder in.* Jadi, detergen dimasukkan setelah mesin cuci diset on/menyala.

**Jawaban: C**

42. Pada teks terdapat kata-kata kunci: *turn the machine on, set it to the wash selection, next wait for the tub to fill with water, the clothes drain through the drain hose, see the knob of the wash timer again, set the knob and wait until the spin processing shuts off.* Maka, dapat dilihat bahwa itu tahapan bagaimana menggunakan mesin cuci.

**Jawaban: A**

43. Perhatikan kalimat 6 dan 7! Terdapat kalimat *After that, see the knob of wash timer again, this time to rinse for three minutes. Do this twice for a good rinsing.*

**Jawaban: D**

44. A. hope = berharap/mengharapkan  
B. think = berpikir  
C. expect = menduga  
D. predict = memperkirakan  
Jawaban yang sesuai adalah *predict*.

**Jawaban: D**

45. A. climate = iklim  
B. weather = cuaca  
C. temperature = temperature/suhu  
D. atmosphere = atmosfer  
Pada kalimat kedua ada kalimat *They expect a global rise in average temperature...* Jadi, pada

kalimat sesudahnya dapat dipastikan jawaban yang tepat adalah *temperature*.

**Jawaban: C**

46. A. absolutely = pasti  
B. naturally = secara alami  
C. totally = secara utuh  
D. fully = secara utuh  
...karena iklim ...berbeda (bentuk dan ukuran) dari tahun ke tahun dan dekade ke dekade, dan butuh waktu lama untuk memastikan perubahan yang mendasar. Kata yang sesuai adalah ***absolutely***.

**Jawaban: A**

47. Rumus: V1 + O1 + preposisi + O2  
Sehingga kalimatnya menjadi, *Keep the cleanliness of our country* = Jagalah kebersihan negara kita.

**Jawaban: B**

48. Rumus dasar: S+V+O+...  
Maka kalimatnya, *The bee stung him sharply and then disappeared into the bus.*  
(8 - 7 - 1 - 6 - 2 - 3 - 9 - 4 - 5)

**Jawaban: C**

49. Susunan cerita yang benar:  
1. Pada zaman dahulu kala, ada sebuah kerajaan di Jawa Timur yang dipimpin oleh Raja Sindureja.  
2. Sidupaksa memiliki istri yang cantik.  
3. Beliau memiliki seorang perdana menteri bernama Sidupaksa.  
4. Mereka hidup berbahagia.  
5. Suatu hari dia berusaha untuk memisahkan Sidupaksa dari istrinya.

Susunan yang tepat adalah 3-1-2-4-5-7-6-8. Dalam menyusun cerita seperti di atas, pertama adalah mulailah dari kalimat yang menunjukkan waktu terjadinya suatu peristiwa yang menjadi dasar dari cerita tersebut, *last week, one upon a time, one day*, dan sebagainya.
